What’s Changing - 2018

Fewer, larger grants ranging between \$15,000 and \$100,000

Up to 60% of the Discretionary Grants budget may be awarded in larger grants

Potential for grant of over \$100,000 for an outstanding, collaborative opportunity

At least 40% of the budget will remain for grants under \$15,000

Additional information is requested:

Audit or review of the previous year

If a charity, must have complied with IRS Form 990 or 990-EZ requirements

A budget for the program (if general organization support is requested, than a budget for the entire organization is requested)

A current list of Board of Directors or Trustees, including identification of Board officers

A brief bio of the President or Executive Director

Statement of Diversity, Equity and Inclusiveness

What’s Not Changing

Application Period May 1st-July 1st; deadline midnight July 1st

Online application process the same - www.bluemountainfoundation.org “Grants and Scholarships” tab

Grants will be paid in the fall
